The parade is April 10th 2010 and contestants will assemble at Wood and F St. By 7:30 am on Saturday morning to receive their contestant number and line up instructions at the information table. (Corner of Wood & F)

Judging- Entries must be in place by 8:00 am. All exhibitors will display their number on the right side of the entry. Entries must complete the parade route or be disqualified. Late arrivals will be removed from the judges list and placed at the rear of the parade.

Awards- Will be given out at the Foothill Shopping Center immediately following the end of the parade. Awards will be handed out until 12:00 noon. **No awards will be mailed or held for latter pick up.**

Rules and Regulations- DO NOT throw candy on the parade route. Entry age effective on the parade date. Line up order must be maintained throughout the parade route. Lead line entries must be led by an adult with a rope throughout the parade. No individual or group shall be in possession or consume any alcoholic beverage during the line-up or parade, or be subject to removal from the parade. All decisions of the judges are final, remember this is not a professional parade and is intended for the enjoyment of the community. Only invited mounted groups and individuals will be allowed in the Grand Entry, and only Grand Entry participants will be allowed in the rodeo at no charge. Grand Entry participants must report to the east gate prior to the rodeo to be admitted.
